

# SIERRA NORTE de MÁLAGA

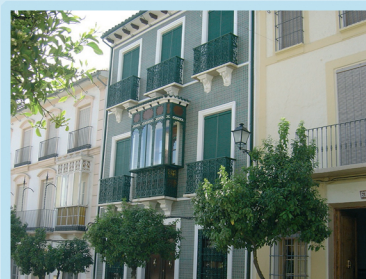
## Plan de Competitividad Turística

A natural corridor between The Vegas of Antequera and Granada, historically a route between the Guadalquivir region and the steppes and mountains area of Andalucía. The northeastern region of Málaga is located in a central position, in a crossroad of routes and cultures.

We can divide this territory into three very differentiated zones: the northern zone formed by the villages of Cuevas Bajas, Cuevas de San Marcos, Villanueva de Tapia and Villanueva de Algaidas; Archidona situated in the centre of the region; and Villanueva del Rosario and Villanueva del Trabuco, located in the southern zone where the landscape has great importance with a chain of mountains that cross the province of Málaga.



Cuevas Bajas is located in a natural depression in the land with a warm climate. Due to its position, there are numerous vegetable gardens and an irrigation system of Greek origin surrounds the village, a place where visitors can take a quiet walk. The urban part of the village offers the visitor many interesting places to visit, especially around the church and the calle Real. The landscape that surrounds the village is made up of soft hills where olive groves dominate. Burriana stream and the banks of the Genil River are located in the area around the village.

- Chacinas caseras (homemade pork sausages)
- Licor de resol o resoli (liqueur made with coffee)
- Typical desserts and cakes
- Roscas de huevo (ring – shaped cakes made with egg)
- Roscas de vino (ring – shaped cakes made with wine)
- Tortas de aceite (olive oil cakes)

### Festivals

- Easter, with a long history
- San Marcos, traditional picnic in the countryside (April 25th)
- San Juan Festival, a very colourful event with open air dancing and music (June 24th)
- August Fair, with open air dancing
- 'Morá' Carrot Day when this product is promoted (first weekend of December)

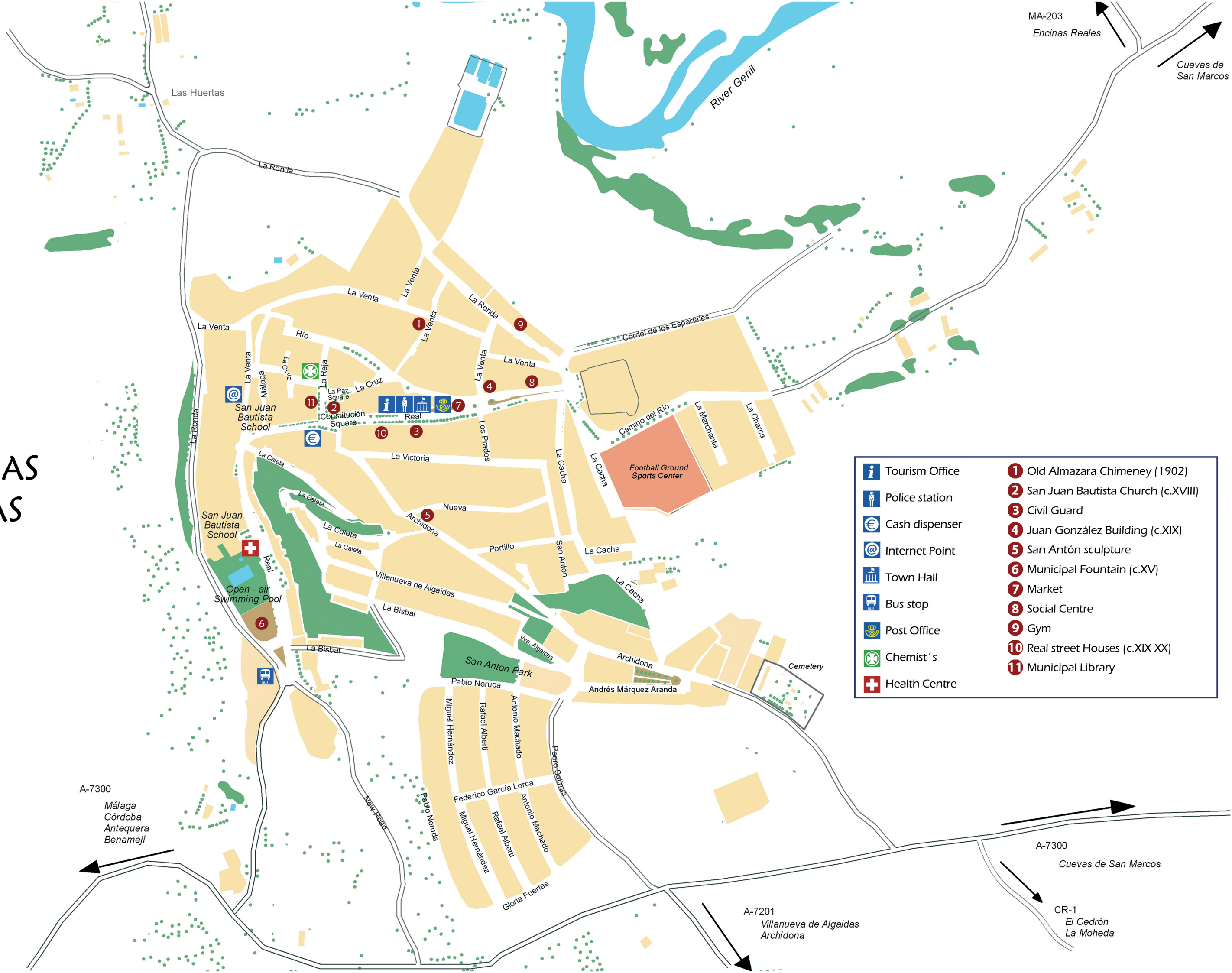
